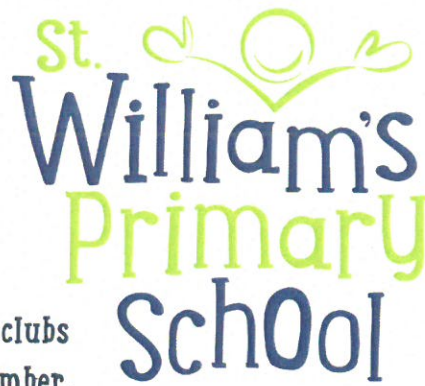

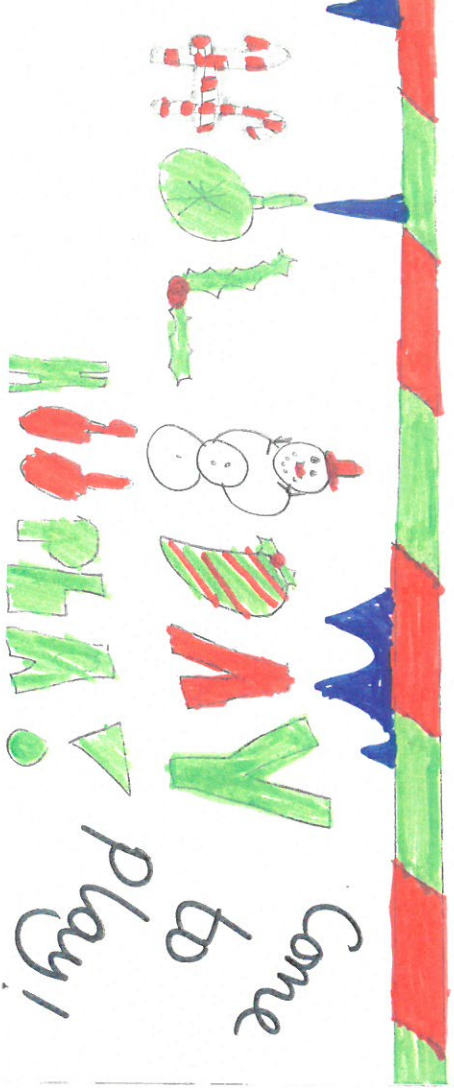

How Do We Help Children Lead Happy and Safe Lives?

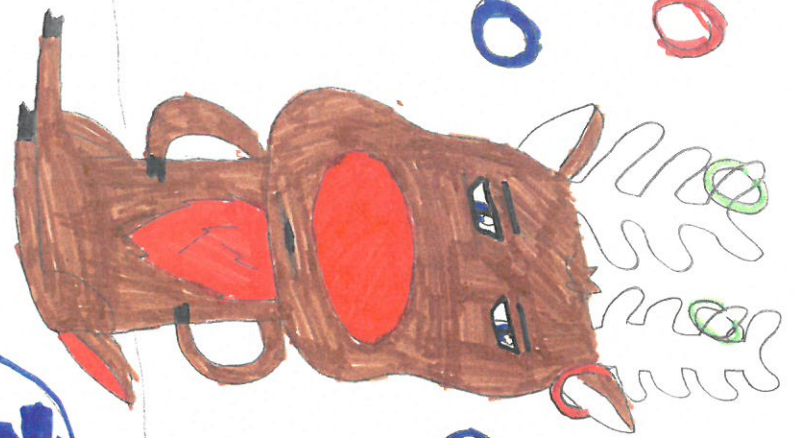
