




Key Stage 2 Results 2018/2019

All children across the country are tested in reading, grammar, punctuation and spelling (GPS) and maths through externally marked tests at the end of Year 6 in order to establish levels of attainment. Writing is assessed by teacher assessment. In 2016 the government changed the method of assessment from national curriculum levels to reporting the proportion of pupils reaching the "expected standard" or "higher standard". Below is an outline of St. William's results for 2019:







Average Scaled Score In Statutory Assessment

Tests:

Reading	Maths
105 (National 104)	104 (National 105)

Pupils achieve 100 to be awarded the expected standard.

Average Progress Scores:

Reading	Writing	Maths
-0.9	-2.4	-1.9

Average progress scores range from -10 to 10, and are compared with a national average of 0.
