

Phase - Key Stage 1 (Year 1 and Year 2)

Daily Activity:

1. Reading (reading book, library book & reading for pleasure)
2. Spellings (learning journal spellings, high frequency words & common exception words)
3. Number facts practise (number bonds to 10, number bonds to 20, doubles, halves & times tables 2, 5 & 10)
4. Handwriting (formation of letters, sizing & first joins(Year 2))
5. Phonics practise (sounds, words, suffixes)

Pick 'n' Mix: These are additional to the daily activities which enable children to practice and embed key skills.
No additional learning opportunities will be set until after the Easter Holiday, if necessary.

Complete a piece of writing based on the picture stimulus (see attached)	Practise your maths skills by completing a daily 5 challenge	Complete the material hunt sheet by identifying and sorting materials around your home	Label the maps of the world. Can you name all of the continents? Can you name the countries and capital cities of the UK? Can you name all the oceans? Can you mark where the equator would be?
Build a tower using paper. What is the tallest tower you can make without glue?	Create your own game. What would the rules be? Do you need cards? Do you need a board? How many players?	Complete the project quiz. How many questions can you answer independently?	Practise your sketching skills (people, flowers & toys). Can you improve your sketching each time you try?
