

EYFS- Nursery

Daily Activity:

1. Number facts – ordering numbers 1-10, counting forwards and backwards to 10, counting groups of objects up to 5.
2. Mark making – practise writing your name with a capital letter for the first letter and lower case letters for the rest.
3. Phonics activity – listen for 1 minute and then talk about the sounds you heard. How do you know what the sounds were? Can you remember the order you heard the sounds. Copy clapping patterns that your grown up shows you. Clap the syllabus in words such as elephant, fish, rabbit, caterpillar.
4. Reading – share your library books for pleasure with a grown up. Re-read your favourite stories.

Pick 'n' Mix: These are additional to the daily activities which enable children to practice and embed key skills. No additional learning opportunities will be set until after the Easter Holiday, if necessary.

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| In one minute how many times can you: hop on one leg, do star jumps, stand up and sit down. What can you think of to do in one minute? | Practise cutting using a knife and fork. Practise spooning water from one bowl to another bowl. | Play a game that involves taking turns and sharing for example board games, card game, eye-spy, pairs and lotto. | Sing some songs: your favourite ones from the radio, youtube, school or nursery rhymes. Can you learn a new song? |
| Find out about how food is grown, transported, used to make other foods or meals and how it is sold to the customers. | Design a front cover for your work book from school. | Use your construction toys to build: a vehicle, a home for a toy, a tower or a restaurant/cafe. | Draw a picture of something you can see from your window. Think carefully about the colours shapes and sizes that you can see. |
| Talk to your family about your favourite foods and why you like them? Talk about foods you have eaten at celebrations with your family. | Practise dressing and undressing independently. Including doing up your own coat and shoes. | Help your grown up around your home. For example sorting the washing, setting the table, drying up, tidying your toys and making your bed. | Role play cafes/restaurants/ shops with your grown ups and your soft toys. Take turns being different characters: waiters, cashiers, cooks, customers. |
