


Daily Expectations – Reception – Daily Challenges

<p>Phonics In your lined paper book</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Practise your flashcard sounds. Which can you remember?• Read and write the words listed. Add sounds buttons and sounds bars to the words: <i>clown, town, gown, foil, spoil, coin, hear, beard, clear</i>• Extension: choose one of the words above and write it in a sentence. Did you write every word in order? Does your sentence make sense? Did you use a full stop after the final word?	
<p>Spellings In your lined book</p>	<p>Please continue to practise your spellings: <i>a, he, she, we, was, my</i></p>	
<p>Reading</p>	<p>Read the next few pages in one of your books? Tell a grown up what happened using full sentences?</p>	
<p>Handwriting In your lined book</p>	<p>Please practise writing the following capital and lowercase letter 5 times starting and finishing all letters in the correct place and making your writing sit on the line: <i>Dd</i></p>	
<p>Maths In your plain book</p>	<p>Challenge 1</p> <p>Can you recall your number pairs to 10. If a grown-up says a number between 1 and 10, can you say the number that goes with it to make 10?</p> <p>Use your fingers or numicon to help.</p> <p>Extension: Can you draw some of these in a 10 frame?</p> 	<p>Challenge 2</p> <p>Can you name these 2d shapes? How many sides do they have? How many corners do they have?</p>
