

## Gate arrangements for those families with more than one child at our school

You need to go to the gate of your youngest child.

If you are going to the gate for...	and also have a child in...	your older children will...
Nursery or Reception (larger gate on Furze Road)	Year 1 or 2	Year 1 and 2 will go straight from the gate to the 'back' door of their classroom.
Nursery or Reception (larger gate on Furze Road)	Year 3	Year 3 will go through the small, pedestrian gate (mainly used by Year 5 and 6), across the Pirate Playground and in through the door at the bottom of their corridor.
Nursery or Reception (larger gate on Furze Road)	Year 4	Year 4 will go through the small, pedestrian gate (mainly used by Year 5 and 6), across the Pirate Playground and in to their classroom by the 'back' door.
Nursery or Reception (larger gate on Furze Road)	Year 5 or 6	The Year 5 and 6 can go in with the others from their Year Group, through the small pedestrian gate.
Year 1 or 2 (Key Stage 1 gate on Williams Loke)	Years 3, 4, 5 or 6	Your Year 3, 4, 5 and 6 children will go through the library gate. You can take them there first or send them down Williams Loke to that gate. There will be a member of staff at the main gate to make sure they cross safely.
Year 3 or 4 (library gate)	Year 5 or 6	Your Year 5 or 6 children will come in the library gate and walk across the Sports Playground, across the Pirate Playground and in to the corridor doors (Y5) or the library doors (Y6).
