

Covid update – 14/12/2021

Dear Families

I hope this finds you safe and well... it's a busy time in school in the final week of a very long term!

We were sent new guidance by the Department for Education last night. If anyone is identified as a close contact by NHS Track and Trace, they are now told to take LFD tests for 7 consecutive days. If they get a positive result, then they should get a PCR test. This guidance includes all children from 5 years old. This is the first time any guidance has advised LFD tests for children under 11.

Throughout this term, we have been informing families if there is a positive case in their child's Year Group. This is the most information we are able to give to keep you informed but also protect people's privacy. As I have said, the identification of close contact still lies with the NHS. We do really appreciate all the cooperation and support we have received from you all throughout this difficult time; it is so important that we all work together to keep each other safe and well.

We are looking forward to the final four days of term and all the excitement that brings.
